FIRE, POLICE AND EMS EMERGENCIES Noise Ordinance #1037

A Noise nuisance, any noise or sound emanating from an electronic device, that is plainly audible to a person at a distance of seventy-five feet (75') is in violation of this ordinance. This is also applicable for noise coming from a motor vehicles audio.

Any persons 17 years of age or younger are to be off the streets or public spaces during the hours of 10:00 pm and 5:00 am. A curfew siren will go off at 9:45 pm as a reminder. This siren will be on from Memorial Day to Halloween.

### Park Ordinance #1032

Children under the age of 9 must be accompanied by an adult. Pets are not permitted to run at large in any park; all pets must be kept on a leach and you must clean and remove all waste.

### **GARBAGE PICKUP**

Regular pickup is Thursday Garbage will be delayed a day for the 4th of July and Labor Day Holidays.

### Open Burning Ordinance #169

All fires must be in an approved container and tended by a responsible person at all times. The maximum size allowed for a burn pile is 3'x3'x3'. Any open flame must be 15 feet from a structure and you must have adequate means of extinguishment available. Burning is prohibited on AIR QUALITY ACTION DAYS. You must use clean, dry wood, no burning of refuse or building materials is prohibited.

### Loitering Ordinance #195


No person shall loiter in a public place in such manner as to create or cause danger, breach of peace, annoyances to any person, or obstruct or interfere with any person. This shall include offensive, disgusting or insulting behavior.
