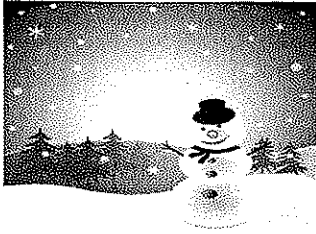

### 2025 GARBAGE DISCOUNT

We will be continuing our garbage service with Big's Sanitation for the upcoming year and will once again be offering the garbage discount. Once your 2024 balance is paid in full you can pay in advance for the 2025 billing. The discount amount is \$160.00 per unit and this must be received before February 28, 2025 to be eligible. This is a savings of \$20.00 per unit for the year.

Delinquent garbage accounts will be sent to MBM collections on January 31, 2025. All payments after that date must be sent to directly to MBM, no delinquent payments will be accepted at the Borough office. You may contact them at (412)242-4400 for account information.

### IMPORTANT WINTER INFORMATION

**DO NOT** shovel or blow your snow into the street, this can cause dangerous road conditions.

**YOU MUST REMOVE SNOW FROM YOUR ENTIRE SIDEWALK, INCLUDING STEPS, WITHIN 24 HOURS OF THE SNOWFALL.**

Parking on some roads may be difficult in the winter months, but you are not permitted to block or save your parking space with any type of object. Borough Roads are all public roadways, which means there are no designated spots for your home or business.

It is illegal to park on yellow curbs, directly under stop signs, blocking handicap accessible ramps, and on sidewalks. Boro ordinances also state that you must park with the flow of traffic.
