MINUTES FROM FEBRUARY 19, 2019 BUSINESS MEETING OF THE BOROUGH

EDITH BARRETT HERMAN AVENUE: I have an Ordinance here regarding our garbage. 255-12 says that garbage collection can be done Monday – Friday between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. and on Saturdays between 8:00a.m. and noon. **NEW BUSINESS:**

**S. SHURGOT:** we received a letter from the Engineer regarding the slide on Orient Avenue and now there are 2 new slides and as you know it is closed. The slide is moving and our engineer estimates that the cost for repairs would be between 500,000.00 to 1,000,000.00. It is the opinion of the engineer that it might be cost effective to purchase 2 houses up there. They are assessed at \$13700.00 and \$14,500.00. The storm sewer would have to be maintained but there is no sanitary sewer and there is no slump at the base on Welsh so it's not threatening those homes. We will continue to get more information.

K. MAXWELL: we received a lease from the Wilmerding Community Center for the equipment but it came over late this morning and the attorney has not had time to review it.
