LAWN CARE

Tenants and homeowners are reminded to keep their grass manicured and under 6 inches in height. You are also responsible for keeping the sidewalks in front of your property clear of debris and weeds. Do not blow your grass into the street, this can make for dangerous conditions.

Failure to comply will result in fines.

2022 INCREASES

Real Estate property tax will be increased by 2 mils for the 2022 tax year. The new rate will be 13 mils.

Garbage will increase from \$36.00 to \$45.00 per quarter per unit for the billing year 2022.

TRASH ORDINANCE #920

We ask that bags not be placed at the curb prior to 6 pm on Wednesday evening. You may not accumulate or burn refuse on your property. All refuse must be stored in containers to prevent the attraction of insect, rodents, and other animals. There will be no pick-up of construction materials, tires, electronics or large amounts of trash from a move out. Big's limits a pick-up to a maximum of 7 bags of trash and 1 large item per week. Failure to comply will result in a fine.

PETS ORDINANCE 899

You are limited to a total of two (2) animals in your residence. If you wish to have more than two (2) you are required to file for a permit through the Borough. The cost is \$15.00 for each addition pet.

ORDINANCE #901

Any person having control of any animal must clean up after their pet if they defecate on any sidewalk, street, public, or private area within the Borough.

PA Code 459-305

States that a dog must be confined to its owners premises and must be secured to the property or person, such as with a collar and leach, so it cannot stray and can remain under control.

PA state law mandates that all dogs over 3 months of age or older must be licensed and this license should be present anytime your dog is outside of your home.
