GARBAGE PICKUP CURFEW ORDINANCE UPCOMING #150 MEETINGS Regular pickup is Thurs, do not place garbage at Any persons 17 years of Meetings Works

Regular pickup is Thurs, do not place garbage at curb before 6 pm on Wed and cans must be removed by Fri. Service will be delayed 1 day for the July 4th and Labor Day.

Any persons 17 years of age or younger are to be off the streets and out of public spaces during the hours of 10:00 pm and 5:00 am.

Park Ordinance #1032

Children under the age of 9 must be accompanied by an adult. Pets are not permitted to run at large in any park; all pets must be kept on a leach and you must clean and remove all waste.

Noise Ordinance #1037

A Noise nuisance, any noise or sound emanating from an electronic device, that is plainly audible to a person at a distance of seventy-five feet (75') is in violation of this ordinance. This is also applicable for noise coming from a motor vehicles audio. Quiet hours are 10 pm to 7 am.
