PARKING

*Please make sure to place your placard in view when parking in a handicap spot.

2024 GARBAGE DISCOUNT

We will be continuing our garbage service with Big's Sanitation for the upcoming year and will once again be offering the garbage discount. Once your 2023 balance is paid in full you can pay in advance for the 2024 billing. The discount amount of \$160.00 per unit must be received before February 29, 2024 to be eligible. This is a savings of \$20.00 per unit for the year.

HOLIDAY GARBAGE COLLECTION

Garbage collection will not be affected by the Holidays. Garbage will be picked up on Thursday December 28th and Thursday January 4th.

GARBAGE PICKUP

Please remember that Big's will not take trash from a "move-out". You are required to contact them to set up a special pickup or dumpster. They will continue to pick up 1 large item per week and require that all bags to be tied if they are not placed in a garbage can. We ask that you do not place your garbage out before 6 pm the day before.
